SUMMARY MEETING**

Week 7 (Summary meeting):

Assemble full group in a setting that is informal and very welcoming. Food and refreshments are encouraged. After a brief social period call meeting to order.

- I. Evangelization Prayer
- II. Welcome, explanation of the gathering
 - a. Goals and objectives for this session
 - i. Identify common threads from small group reflections and share personal discoveries from the process.
 - ii. Constructive assessment of the pilot process and suggestions for feedback to the archdiocese (reemphasize that this is only the first phase -- **awakening** -- of a multi-year process. Subsequent phases will focus on **transformation** and **witness**.)
 - iii. Assessment of steps needed to foster this phase in the broader parish or organization.
- III. Break into your small groups
(Designate one person to take notes)
 - a. Allow enough time to work through the questions in the Summary Guide: Share discoveries and record common threads.
- IV. Gather in large group
(Use of white board or poster paper may be useful here)
 - a. Identify and record common threads from small groups. Possibly coalesce into a few key statements.
 - b. Examine how these threads correlate with individual's understanding of evangelization and the archdiocesan definition: Making Jesus Christ known and loved in our time by choosing to live out the Gospel in every moment.
 - c. Explore what steps may be necessary for fostering the "awakening" phase throughout your greater parish community.
 - d. Invite participants of the group to consider what role they would be able to play for the rollout of the process to the greater parish.
