### **Preschool/Kindergarten Supplemental Materials**

Use Modified Lesson Plan from PCYI office.

### **Grades 1 – 6 Supplemental Materials: NetSmartz: Know the Rules**

Grades 1, 3 and 5 does the first two themed lessons: “Check First” and “Take a Friend”.

Grades 2, 4, and 6 does the third and fourth themed lessons: “Tell People ‘No’” and “Tell a Trusted Adult”.

In this way, children receive all four reminders every other year with a developmentally deeper understanding. The DVD may be used to introduce and/or conclude the lessons. It is probably most age-appropriate for Grades 1, 2 and 3.

The lessons may be taught in two shorter time segments or combined into one 50 – 80 minute session.

### **Grades 7 and 8 Supplemental Materials: Power of Parents: Real-World and Internet Safety**

Grade 7 does “Level I Middle School” lessons.

Grade 8 does “Level II Middle School” lessons.

Real-World Safety lesson involves mostly discussion.

Internet Safety lesson includes vignettes on archdiocesan DVD included with materials.

“You Can’t Take it Back” and “Broken Friendship” are found in the “Cyberbullying” track of the DVD.

### **Grade 9 or Youth Ministry Supplemental Materials: Diocese of Orange: Breaking the Silence**

This is best suited as an introduction to Fr. McGlone’s “Creating Safe and Sacred Places” at the 9<sup>th</sup> grade level or if Fr. McGlone’s materials are used in 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade, this would be well-suited for youth ministry programs.

An archdiocesan lesson plan is included with materials. There are suggestions for teens and also suggestions for parents, if separate gatherings are planned.
