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<p><u>Tell People “ No”</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> — if I am are scared, uncomfortable, or confused — if someone tries to touch me in a way that bothers me <p><i>Internet Safety Pledge</i> I will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> — turn off my computer monitor right away and tell a trusted adult if anything makes me feel scared, uncomfortable, or confused — not respond to any messages that are mean or in any way make me feel uncomfortable — not use rude or mean language on the Internet 	<p>Respect that each person is created in God’s image and likeness(K-2)</p> <p>Give examples of how we show respect for all life (6)</p> <p>Understand and act on moral norms concerning speech (6)</p> <p>Demonstrate respect for all living things (K-2)</p> <p>Acknowledge that the body is sacred because each person is made in God’s image (K-2)</p> <p>Express how each person is responsible for one’s own life and decisions (3-5)</p> <p>Choose to respect the human body as a Temple of the Holy Spirit (6)</p> <p>Show respect and responsibility for all life (K-2)</p> <p>Name ways to defend those whose dignity or life is threatened (3-5)</p> <p>Relate sources of violence, oppression, and injustice and how they impact today’s society (6)</p>	<p><i>Standard One: Promoting Knowledge of the Faith</i> (CCC #362-367)</p> <p>D. 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<p><u>Tell a Trusted Adult</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> — if anything happens to me — if something is bothering me or when a problem becomes too big for me to handle <p><i>Internet Safety Pledge</i> I will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> — turn off my computer monitor right away and tell a trusted adult if anything makes me feel scared, uncomfortable, or confused — tell my parents or guardian if anyone online asks me my name, my address, my telephone number, or the name and location of my school. — tell my parents or guardian if anyone online asks to meet me in person — show an offensive message to a trusted adult right away so that he or she can decide if it's necessary to contact the online service or other authorities 	<p>Show respect for those in authority (K-2)</p> <p>Acknowledge how [the 10 Commandments ...] guide us (e.g. telling the truth) (3-5)</p> <p>Apply the 10 Commandments to daily living (6)</p> <p>Internalize God's unconditional love and mercy (K-2)</p> <p>Describe how to use critical reflection when encountering a moral problem (3-5)</p> <p>Understand the role and authority of adults within the family and acknowledge the roles and responsibilities of children within the family structure.
